- Invest in 'First News' in KS2, developing and encouraging debates about current affairs.
- Develop understanding of propaganda.
- Develop understanding that people have different views on things and how this affects the world.

- We have a Rewards & Sanctions system- traffic lights in KS2 and sun, cloud, rainy cloud in EYFS and KS1

- Bikeability takes place each year for Year 6 children
- We hold E-Safety assemblies for children.
- We participate in Worsley Sports.
- We invite the emergency services in to teach us how rules keep us safe.

- Hold an e safety event for parents.
- Develop inter- school sporting tournaments with our family of schools.
- Learn about the English civil and criminal law.

- Invite the school governors for open days twice per year to watch us engaged in our learning.
- Invest in 'First News' project in KS2, choosing what we want to read and forming an opinion about it.
- Creating a class newspaper in year 6 to sell to other children.
