A letter has been emailed to all parents/carers with children in Reception and Nursery.

I am pleased to be able to confirm that Mrs Thorpe will continue to teach Reception class for the duration of the summer term with support from Mrs Cosgrave who will lead EYFS in the interim until school appoints a new EYFS lead and classroom teacher who will join us in September. I will keep EYFS parents informed of this in due course.
