

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**Dogs:** Earlier this week an incident was reported to school that a dog scratched a child's face just outside school premises. We are seeing an increase in the number of dogs being walked to school and I would just like to remind you that dogs are NOT allowed onto school premises and this includes dogs being carried.

We would ask parents and carers not to use the school drop off as an opportunity to walk your dog as you are coming to a busy area with a lot of children who may not always act appropriately around dogs. If you choose to walk your dog to school, it must be supervised outside the school gates by an adult at all times, especially when the children are present. Dogs must not be tied up and left unsupervised.

We would also ask that all parents talk to their child to help them understand how to act around dogs and not to approach a dog they do not know.

Thank you for your co-operation in this matter.
