Notes: Schools faced a new curriculum and a new standard, with new tests, measured in a completely different way. No conclusions about trends can be drawn from this data; we've started from scratch.

The floor and coasting standards for schools consist of both attainment and progress measures. If a school is above threshold on progress, it is above the standard altogether. Therefore, no school can be described at this time as being below the floor or as coasting. Progress score is a relative measure formed in comparison to other schools' results. What we do know is that no more than 6% of primary schools in the country can be below the progress threshold as the government has set a firm cap.
