Glossary of Vocabulary

- Pattern— Something that repeats over and over
- Sketch—A drawing that is not the finished piece
- Symmetry— Looks exactly the same on one side to the other
- Reflection—The angle of incidence that reflects back the image
- Stencil—A piece of plastic that has a design cut out of it
