- Children have threaded in and out of a weave to make a pattern.

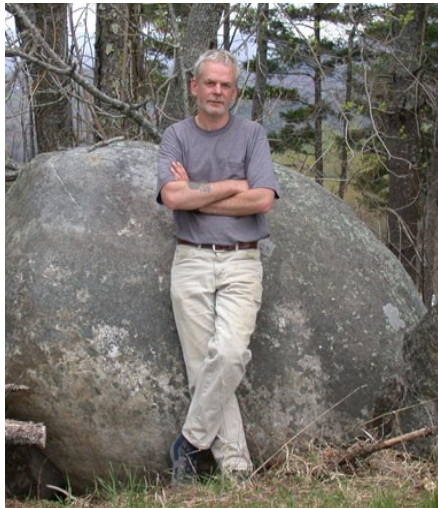

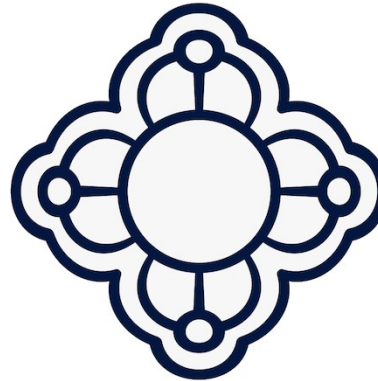

Glossary of Vocabulary

- Painting** - Applying paint or other media to a surface
- Nature**— A focus of a piece of Art. Using natural objects to complete a piece of work.
- Sculpture** - Hard or plastic materials formed in the shape of a figure.
- Abstract** - Using shapes, colours and objects to create an effect.
- Weave**- Crossing one group of thread in and out of another.
