Payment Details

Missed Lessons & Cancellation Policy

- If your child is absent from a lesson refunds will not be available as the payment is to cover our tutors time and to secure your child's place each half term.
- In extreme circumstances where the child is absent for a long period of time, please contact us to put payments on hold and to save your child's place.
- If your child misses a lesson due to a school trip you will not be charged.
- If you would like to withdraw your child from lessons at any point, we require a half term's written notice (by email or letter) to allow changes to the registers to take place.
