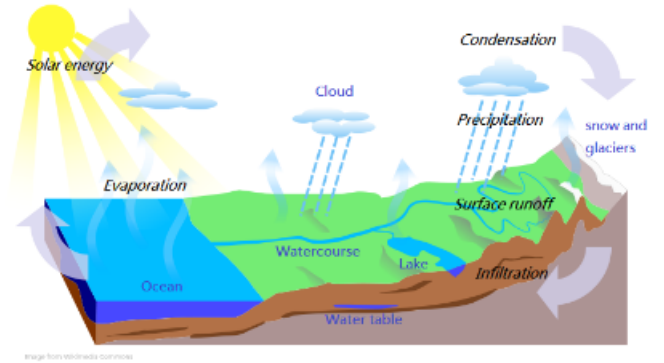

- The water cycle is a cycle that describes the continuous movement of water on, above and below the surface of the Earth.
- Weather is the temporary conditions of the atmosphere.
- Climate is the average weather conditions of a location, over a period of time.
- A meteorologist is the name given to a person who studies the weather.

**Glossary of Vocabulary**

- **Evaporation**—happens when liquid turns into a gas.
- **Condensation**—is when water vapour (which is a gas) becomes a liquid.
- **Precipitation**—water that falls from clouds, i.e. rain and snow.
- **Weather**—is temporary conditions of the atmosphere.
- **Climate**—the average weather condition of a location, over a period of time.
- **Meteorologist**—name given to a person who studies the weather.
